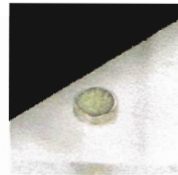
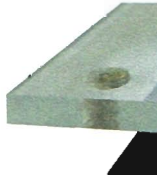
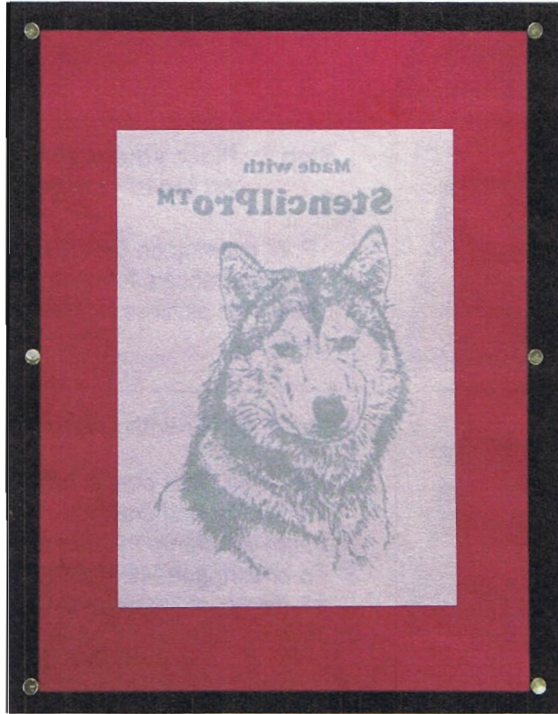


# Deluxe Exposure Frame

8½" x 11" (21.6cm x 27.9cm)







## Constructed using:

3/16" clear acrylic sheet

1/4" black PVC base with black flocked foam

12 powerful magnets to clamp your drawing and film firmly together during exposure

# Instructions

	<p><b>Step 1: Place stencil film on black flock.</b></p> <p>As is, either side up.</p>
	<p><b>Step 2: Place your drawing <b>upside down</b> on top of your stencil film.</b></p> <p>Print drawing on Circuit Bridge Ink-Jet Transparencies for best results. Paper shown in pictures for illustration purposes only.</p>
	<p><b>Step 3: Cover with clear plastic frame.</b></p> <p>Place the clear plastic frame over the stencil film and drawing. Magnets in the frame will clamp the two parts together. To ensure good contact press down on the center of the contact frame.</p>
	<p><b>Step 4: Expose.</b></p> <p>Use the exposure times recommended for your stencil film type in the instruction book as a guideline. We recommend testing with a small piece first and make changes in exposure time accordingly.</p> <p><b>Hard to wash out:</b> Decrease exposure time.</p> <p><b>Design washing out:</b> Increase exposure time.</p>
